***Ageing With Attitude* Art Show Opens on the Web**

Ann Arbor, MI— The Blueprint for Aging’s groundbreaking art exhibit, *Ageing with Attitude*, is now available on the Web.

Viewers begin their “virtual stroll” through the exhibit on the Blueprint’s homepage, www.BlueprintForAging.org. A few easy clicks display all the artworks as thumbnail portraits. Clicking on a particular thumbnail will reveal a larger view, complete with artist’s statement. Visitors can also choose to move through the entire exhibit from beginning to end, spending as much time examining each piece as they desire.

The Blueprint for Aging (BFA) is a collaborative of consumers, public, private, non-profit agencies and donors working to build systems that will make Washtenaw County a great place to age. The *Ageing with Attitude* exhibit is one of several BFA events designed to spark and sustain active discussion about growing older in our community. Feedback from these events indicates that they have the power to shift the way people think about the aging process. The Blueprint is harnessing that power to improve the way Washtenaw County addresses the needs of its rapidly growing elder population.

The BFA offers the virtual catalog of *Ageing With Attitude* with the hope that the thought-provoking, multi-media works found there may expand our shared viewpoint about the possibilities and potential of aging residents.
